Forensic Applications Consulting Technologies, Inc. (FACTs) has begun a series of regulatory audits of reports submitted to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) pursuant to 6 CCR 1014-3 “*Regulations Pertaining To The Cleanup Of Methamphetamine-Affected Properties.*”

FACTs performed a detailed regulatory audit for the report titled:

As you know, this particular untrained consultant (Judith E Sawitsky with Weecycle (WEC)) has an extended history of regulatory violations,^{1,2,3,4} false information on real estate related documents and claims to her credentials that cannot be supported.

As you are also aware, this consultant is fraudulently representing herself as an Industrial Hygienist, leaving numerous victims in her wake. Including this report, FACTs has identified a total of eight hundred and thirty eight regulatory violations by this contractor in just three reports.

For this property, this particular contractor is so badly trained, and her work is so patently deceptive, In several locations, Ms Sawitsky has actually collected samples by merely placing a 100 cm² template over an item, containing mostly empty space and making the unsupportable argument that the area within the template as collected using a three pass method was 100 cm² (obviously, a physical impossibility). Two examples are given below:



Section 3.1 of Part 3, of 6 CCR 1014-3 requires enforcement actions on the part of the CDPHE whenever the CDPHE has reason to believe that a person has violated any requirement of the regulations. Using a degree of scrutiny for reviews developed and deployed by your office, FACTs has thus far identified a total of eight *thousand*, six hundred and three (8,603) regulatory violations of 6 CCR 1014-3 which your office has either ignored or, in many cases, you have actively suborned the concealment of these violations.
