RE: 179 Regulatory Violations: 3324 S Field Street, Building 10, Unit 183, Lakewood, Colorado

Dear Ms. Brisnehan:

Forensic Applications Consulting Technologies, Inc. (FACTs) has begun a series of regulatory audits of reports submitted to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) pursuant to 6 CCR 1014-3 "Regulations Pertaining To The Cleanup Of Methamphetamine-Affected Properties."

Using a degree of scrutiny for reviews developed and deployed by the CDPHE, FACTs has thus far identified a total of six *thousand* four hundred and seventy five (6,475) violations of 6 CCR 1014-3.

As you know, Section 3.1 of Part 3, of 6 CCR 1014-3 requires enforcement actions on the part of the CDPHE whenever the CDPHE has reason to believe that a person has violated any requirement of the regulations.

FACTs performed a detailed regulatory audit for the report titled:

As you know, the author of the report, Thomas D. Koch, has an extended history of regulatory violations and performing invalid assessments. ^{1,2,3,4} FACTs has reviewed

only two of his reports since December 15, 2015, wherein we have identified no fewer than 677 (six hundred and seventy seven) regulatory violations. In spite of Mr. Koch's history of regulatory violations, The Department nevertheless awarded Mr. Koch Certification of Qualified Instructor.

Although Mr. Koch did not collect any clearance samples from this property in accordance with the State regulations, he nevertheless declared the property compliant. Naturally, we are concerned for the public safety of the innocent occupants, and the construction personnel, who may now be exposed to potentially toxic materials.
