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## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

On August 8, 2007, Mr. Peter Cappel, an industrial hygienist, with Gobbell Hays Partners, Inc. (GHP), conducted an assessment for methamphetamine contamination in the single family home located at 4690 West 76<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Westminster, Colorado.

Based on information provided by the owner, it was reported to GHP that the use and possible manufacture of methamphetamines had previously taken place in the house.

## 2.0 METHAMPHETAMINE TESTING ASSESSMENT

### 2.1 Property Description:

The property is located at 4690 West 76<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Westminster, Colorado. It is a single family ranch home with a detached garage. The first floor has a bathroom, kitchen/dining area, living room, two bedrooms and one room addition on the south side of the home. The basement level has a central seating area, large storage area, laundry/furnace room, bathroom and two bedrooms. Heat is provided by a natural gas forced air furnace. There is a detached oversized two-car garage to the south and east of the house.

### 2.2 Police Reports:

Ms. Tousky, the current owner of the home, provided GHP with a Westminster Police report dated August 26, 2003, identified as OCA: 2003-12001. This report, indicated that during an arrest, an amount of methamphetamine was seized on August 26, 2003. The report also mentions “that address has a recent history for having vehicles associated that are stolen, have fictitious plates, suspended drivers, and controlled substance cases.”

### 2.3 Structural Features:

The first floor has a bathroom, kitchen/dining area, living room, two bedrooms and one room addition on the south side of the home. The basement level has a central seating area, large storage area, laundry/furnace room, bathroom and two bedrooms. Heat is provided by a natural gas forced air furnace. There is a detached oversized two-car garage to the south and east of the house. There is an attic space with access through a ceiling access on the west end of the upstairs hall.

### 2.4 Manufacturing Methods:

The attached police report does indicate that evidence of meth was found in the home at the time of the documented arrest on August 26, 2003.

### 2.5 Chemicals Used:

The attached police report does not indicate that chemicals/products used in the manufacturing of meth were found at the time of the arrest on August 26, 2003.



## 2.6 Areas of Contamination:

Seventeen (17) wipe samples, including two field blanks, were collected in the home and garage. Refer to the sample log in Appendix A for location descriptions for the wipe samples.

Analysis was conducted by Data Chem Laboratories, Inc. in Salt Lake City, Utah, which is a qualified laboratory for meth analysis. Eight (8) of the methamphetamine wipe samples were above the Colorado regulation cleanup level of  $0.5 \mu\text{m}/100\text{cm}^2$ . A copy of the full laboratory report is attached to this report in Appendix B. Based on the wipe sample results, contamination was found throughout the house and garage.

Based on the preliminary assessment conducted by GHP, the house and garage is determined to be methamphetamine contaminated. Sampling was done in accordance with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environmental (CDPHE) regulations 6CCR 1014-3 Regulations pertaining to the cleanup of methamphetamine laboratories.

**2.7 Chemical Storage:**

The attached police report does not indicate that chemicals/products used in the manufacturing of meth were found storage at the property at the time of the arrest on August 26, 2003.

**2.8 Waste Disposal:**

The occurrence of waste disposal associated with meth manufacturing could not be determined either from interviews or subsequent investigations conducted by GHP.

**2.9 Cooking Areas:**

The attached police report does not indicate evidence of meth cooking in the home at the time of the arrest on August 26, 2003.

**2.10 Plumbing System Impact:**

Visual inspection of the various sinks and floor drain did not reveal staining indicative of previous waste disposal.

**2.11 Adjacent Areas Affected:**

The property is a single family home and there are no attached adjacent structures that would be impacted by activities in the home or garage.

**2.12 Ventilation:**

Heat is provided to the home by a nature gas forced air furnace.



### 3.0 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) regulation 6 CCR-1014-3 requires that properties determined to be methamphetamine contaminated be either decontaminated or demolished. The regulation states that if the property is to be decontaminated that clearance sampling must be performed and that all samples collected be below the clearance level of 0.50  $\mu\text{g}/100\text{cm}^2$ .

A specialized decontamination plan should be developed to decontaminate contents and the interior surfaces of the home.

Waste management shall be conducted in accordance with the Colorado Hazardous Waste Regulations (6 CCR 1007-3) and the Colorado Solid Waste Regulations (6 CCR 1007-2). Debris and contaminated material generated during methamphetamine lab decontamination shall be managed as solid waste, with notification provided to the landfill for methamphetamine lab contaminated material. All state, county and local regulations pertaining to the cleanup and disposal of waste must be followed.

#### 3.1 Methamphetamine Contamination Disclosure

This report and all records pertaining to this methamphetamine remediation project should be retained for a minimum of seven years. Methamphetamine contamination disclosure is now required due to the passage of Assembly Bill 1025, (Methamphetamine Contaminated Property Cleanup Act of 2005). It is now required for a property owner to disclose in writing to a prospective buyer or tenant if local health officials have issued an order prohibiting the use or occupancy of a property contaminated by methamphetamine laboratory activity. The owner must also give a copy of the pending order to the buyer to acknowledge receipt in writing. The bill also establishes remediation and re-occupancy standard for determining when a property, contaminated as a result of methamphetamine activity, is safe for human occupancy. Local health officials, after conducting an investigation, are also required to issue an order prohibiting the use or occupancy and to post the order on the property, in addition to the property owner taking specific actions. Failure to comply with these, and all requirements of AB 1025, may subject an owner to, among other things, a civil penalty up to \$5000. Aside from disclosure requirements, AB 1025 also outlines procedures for local authorities to deal with methamphetamine contaminated properties, including filing of a lien against a property until the owner cleans up contamination or pays for cleanup costs.

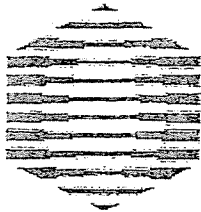

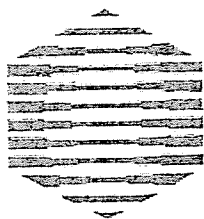

At approximately 2025 hrs Officer Koester observed a female enter the Nissan and drive westbound on 76th Av. Officer Koester aured this information via radio to Officer Welsh and myself. We were in the area with anticipation to make a traffic stop.

The Nissan rapidly accelerated toward 76th Av. I was one quarter to one half of a mile ahead of Officer Koester and I maintained visual on the car. I stated that the female was driving at a high rate of speed and changed lanes. I then stated that the vehicle made an abrupt lane change and left turn into a parking lot after I turned on my pursuit lights to clear the intersection to stay up with the vehicle after she ran through the red light at 80th Ave and Sheridan Blvd.

I again made contact with the Nissan in the "Big Lots" parking lot. The vehicle was parked in a fire lane in front of the store, directly in front of a "no parking" sign.

Officer Welsh and I observed the female driver enter the Big Lots store. She was wearing a long white "summer" dress.

Officer Koester and I contacted the female in the southwest corner of the store. When she saw us she dropped a small pouch connected to a single key. I took the female into custody. The female driver was later identified as Crystal Lee Longanetti, DOB of 12-02-63. Longanetti was cleared through dispatch and came back cancelled/denied for an unpaid ticket, case number 02-327099, dates 111802-indefinite. Longanetti could not provide valid insurance on the vehicle. Longanetti stated the vehicle was her boyfriend's, but found inside the vehicle was clothing, purses, and items that had Longanetti's name on them.
